

Bluetooth microphone setup

When switching a microphone that is significantly different from the microphone used when creating your Dragon voice file, a new voice file may be recommended, if not required.



1. Launch Dragon—give it time if it is loading your usual voice file
2. Click “NaturallySpeaking” in the Dragon toolbar
3. Click “Open” to open a user file
4. Click “NEW” to start a new user file
5. Type your name or initial with the word “wireless” or “blue” after it such as:
Examples: **E-Blue** or **E-Wireless**
Just be sure that the new name for your new voice file is different from other voice files you use
6. Change the “input” device from the default (mic in jack) to the USB microphone option
7. Click NEXT
8. Follow “on screen” instructions
9. After Dragon finishes initializing your new voice file, you'll be asked to run your Vocabulary Builder (VB)—
10. Click “SKIP”—which is not recommended (*run the VB later from Accuracy Center*)
11. Click “Next”
12. Click “Begin Dictating”
13. You've completed the initialization feature and have a new, wireless voice file.

Once done, I review the following under TOOLS/OPTIONS:

Correction:

Checkmark the “Correct command brings up spell dialog box”
Checkmark the “Spell command brings up spell dialog box”

Startup/Shutdown:

Confirm that the “Launch in QuickStart mode” option is OFF (unchecked)*
(Optional) change mouse motion speed from “2” to “12”
